AB: Yeah, I think people think it's...em...kind of impressive or something, y'know, and...eh, I suppose that's kind of the nice thing about it, I suppose...when I had left Bank of Ireland, I...I'd a lot of interviews and I was offered quite a few jobs or when I was in the process of leaving and...I'd kept on saying 'no' y'know...I didn't want to work there and eventually, em...this guy who was, y'know, this particular recruitment guy who was, y'know...spent a lot of time trying to get me something said like *I can't believe you're going to accept this job* y'know, and I said *ah, no it sounds good, y'know, and I'm quite happy to take it*. So, I guess the proof's in the pudding...I'm still here 12 years later, is it...yeah.
